## SHERROD BROWN VOTES WITH ELIZABETH WARREN 95% OF THE TIME

*Frost: Brown 100% Out of Touch with Ohio Voters*

**Cleveland, OH** - As Senator [Sherrod Brown prepares to welcome his liberal colleague, Massachusetts Senator Elizebeth Warren to Cleveland](#) for a fundraiser to benefit his 2018 re-election campaign, Cuyahoga County Republican Party Chairman Rob Frost issued the following statement, reminding Ohio voters that Sherrod Brown votes with Liberal Massachusetts Senator Elizabeth Warren 95 percent of the time and has taken at least \$10,000 in campaign contributions from her.

“Sherrod Brown and Elizabeth Warren are perfect for each other, but bad for Ohio. They are both fond of voting for major tax increases, including a massive death tax. They are dangerously liberal together on national security, seeing eye-to-eye in supporting Obama’s ill-advised Iran Deal and promoting sanctuary cities. And not only do Warren and Brown share a love for Obamacare, even worse, they both support a single-payer healthcare system. In fact, Sherrod Brown votes with Elizabeth Warren 95% of the time, putting him 100% out of touch with Ohio voters.

“Sherrod Brown and Elizabeth Warren are a match made in Massachusetts, but unfortunately for Brown, he works for the people of Ohio.
