CAREER POLITICIAN SHERROD BROWN FLIP FLOPS ON NORTH KOREA

Cleveland, OH - Yesterday, Ohio Senator Sherrod Brown had a true John Kerry moment - he applauded President Trump for re-designating North Korea as a state sponsor of terrorism, yet in 2009, he voted against an amendment in the U.S. Senate that would have called on the State Department for just such a designation for North Korea.
